<u>Theme:</u> Autumn, Harvest and Growth <u>Colour:</u> Orange <u>Shape:</u> Square



<u>Autumn Hunt</u>

Go on an Autumn Hunt with your child around a park, countryside, home etc. Look out and talk about signs of Autumn. For example: falling leaves, squirrels, acorns, pinecones, colder days, conkers etc.

- Bring some materials back and use them for creations and drawing.
 - -Sort the materials found.

<u>Nature</u>

Use Autumn materials to create Autumn creations:

- Leaf prints
- Leaf rubbings
- Conker rolling
- Pinecone rolling
- Play dough creations
- Leaf men

Bake with your child

Use some Harvest produce to bake with your child. For example:

- Chocolate apples
- Apple tart
- Vegetable soup



<u>I spy colour</u>

We are exploring colours (red, green, yellow and blue) in our environment. Play games of 'I spy colour' with your child to help their colour recognition.

Look out for squares in your house and outside.

Talk to your child about their peers and the activities they get up to at Nursery. Have a look on seesaw for inspiration.

<u>Play-Dough</u>

The children at Nursery love exploring play dough. Make some play-dough with your child and create different Autumn animals and materials.

<u>Recipe</u>

Ingredients 560g plain flour 560g salt 850ml warm water 8 tablespoons cooking oil 8 teaspoons cream of tartar Paint / Food colouring – colour optional (Autumn colours) Method Heat water until almost boiling Add colour and oil Mix in dry ingredients Mix until springy dough is formed Cool and store
